

ORGAN AND PIANO ACCOMPANIST OPPORTUNITY • BON AIR PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH (RICHMOND, VA)

Bon Air Presbyterian Church (BAPC), in Richmond, Virginia, seeks a part-time organ and piano accompanist (8-12 hours/week).

A member of the Presbytery of the James of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.), BAPC is located in northern Chesterfield County, just south and west of Richmond, Virginia. As we seek and serve Christ, sharing God's love for all creation, we embrace being a diverse congregation – open, affirming, supportive of each other, and demonstrating faithfulness through worship, education, fellowship, and service.

A successful candidate will:

- have experience playing organ and piano in church.
- embrace and expand the church's spiritual music in all its diverse genres and varieties.
- seek to collaborate enthusiastically with the music director and pastor.
- recognize and nurture the musical gifts of the congregation.
- appreciate the flexibility of part-time work while understanding the ebb and flow of the church calendar.

Specifically, the new accompanist will:

- serve as accompanist on our Zimmer pipe organ and Bechstein grand piano at Sunday worship services (two services September - May, one service June - August) and at special services (primarily Easter and Christmas weeks).
- serve as accompanist for adult chancel choir rehearsal (currently scheduled on Wednesday nights) and at Sunday worship services (Sept. – May).
- when possible, play at weddings and funerals at BAPC (which will yield additional income).

This position will be supervised by the Director of Music and is contingent upon the prospective candidate completing a successful background check. The salary range is up to 17,000, depending on prior experience. Paid vacation and sick-day allowance are included.
