



THE BAPC SESSION REPORTS

At the January 15, 2023, Stated Session Meeting

- Church and Society presented a motion asking that the Session requests the Church and Society Division and the BAPC Peace/Study Group to undertake a study to determine whether BAPC should become a Matthew 25 Congregation as defined by the PCUSA. Moderator Creager offered an amendment to the motion that the study should be explored at the Session level. First amendment to the motion was seconded and passed resulting in the complete motion of: Church and Society requests Session undertake a study to determine whether BAPC should become a Matthew 25 Congregation as defined by the PCUSA. Elder Houghton offered an amendment to the amended motion that was seconded and approved. The final motion reads, Church and Society requests Session, with input from a leadership team, undertake a study to determine whether BAPC should become a Matthew 25 Congregation as defined by the PCUSA.
- Elder Jackson from Stewardship reported that the current surplus from FY22 is \$89,663.22
- Motion made by Stewardship and Finance that \$30,000 of the Operating Surplus for 2022 be transferred to the Deferred Maintenance Fund #3723 and the balance of the surplus (\$59,663.22) be transferred to the Operating Reserve Fund #3100 was approved.
- Motion made by Stewardship and Finance to use the Sieben gift of \$21,000 received in December 2022 for the following: up to \$10,000 to purchase new copier and toner, \$300 to Communications Ministry Team for banners for the food drive and the remainder to be determined (funds will stay in temporary holding) was approved.


